The calligrapher speaks of the importance of the rosary (tasbih) in Muslim prayer. The most remarkable features are to be seen in the letters. These have been employed to produce an outline for various designs which fill the blank spaces within. The detail shows human and animal figures along with varieties of plants and flowers. Each one of them has been outlined in black and shaded in red ink.
