<p>En: Branched Murex, Ramose/Ram's Murex; Sn: <i>Chicoreus ramosus</i> (Linnaeus, 1758); Ln: Baro Kata Shamuk. Shell very large, thick, heavy and rounded. Spire low; 2-3 whorls with 3 small tuberculated varices; distinct suture. Large and globose body whorls with strong spinose varices. All whorls bear numerous spiral cords. Exterior whitish with few light brown spots and a few rusty pink near the sutures, on varices and the apex of spines; inside and siphonal canal white. Spines blackish.</p>
