13.	Brief Description of the Assignment: Bangladesh National Museum has undertaken a program under the title "Renovation, Repairing & Modernization of Bangladesh National Museum". This EOI is for Renovation, Repairing & Modernizing (1) Conference Room and (2) Sufia Kamal Auditorium (3) Renovation of Toilet (4) Museum Light Installation (5) Marble stone setting on floor from Entrance Lobby to Nalinikanta Bhattashali Exhibition Gallery and (6) Related other works, as required for the BNM. The Service Provider will have to inspect the site and ascertain the need of the same and produce specification, Design, Plan, layout of Decoration approved by the client (BNM). Supply/install/Renovation, Repairing, Modernizing and all kinds of installation in due time.	
14.	Experience, Resources and Delivery Capacity Required: Only truly capable firms and companies (or, group of firms/companies) having essential competence and with significant experience of working for a museum or such other institutions are hereby called upon to express their interest (EOI) on organizational letterhead for doing the job on quality in time. Expression of Interest (EOI) letter, addressed to the undersigned, together with required documents, duly signed and authenticated, shall be submitted in sealed envelope and delivered to the address of the undersigned by 03 February 2016 (by hand, or courier or postal service). The envelope must be clearly marked "Expression of Interest for Renovation, Repairing & Modernization of Bangladesh National Museum". Intending firms/companies must be able to engage capable consultants, professionals and expert workers for the job, with proven track record of quality art work with sensibility of working for a delicate place like museum. All works must be done by 30 April 2016.	
15.	Other Details: Documents to be submitted with the letter to express interest are: (a) Trade license renewed for current fiscal year, (b) Company certificate of incorporation (in case of a company) (c) National ID card of the CEO/MD, (d) Value Added Tax (VAT) number, (e) Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN), (f) Income tax certificate for the assessment year 2015-2016, (g) Experience of working for one museum in last three years. (Of an amount of not less than BDT Two Crore) (h) Proof of turnover of no less than the budgeted amount every year in last three years. (i) Bank liquidity /Bank credit facility/Working capital certificate adequate for the job. It is underscored that copies off all documents to be submitted must be duly authenticated by a senior officer of the government. Failure to submit any of the above documents or obvious inadequacy may disqualify the firm/companies for the job. Given the nature of the job (variety of tasks), a firm/company may league up with up to two other firms/companies (e.g. JVCA) etc. for attaining necessary collective capability, as provided in Public Procurement Act/Rules.
